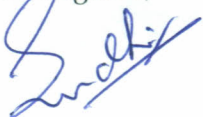
Dear Sir,

CRISIL have audited the Placement Report prepared by Xavier Institute of Management, Bhubaneswar (XIM-B), for the final placements of students in the MBA-HRM batch of 2014-16. CRISIL has validated the information provided in the report with the relevant documentation, and offers the following comments:

1. CRISIL have obtained all information and explanations as were necessary for conducting the audit. We believe the Placement Report complies with the requirements of Indian Placement Reporting Standards (IPRS) Version 2.1.
2. The validation of information presented in the report is based on communication received by XIM-B from the recruiting companies. CRISIL has not independently sourced any information or documentation.
3. CRISIL have verified the information with respect to remuneration, job function and location presented in the report with communication received from recruiters. Information regarding compensation received from individual students has not been used.
 - a. Where offer letters or other recruiter communications were not available, the report indicates it as "Data not available". Data was not available for 42 students who sought placements through the institute. We have not been able to verify the status of 42 students in the absence of required data.
 - b. The information has been categorized as best as possible under various salary heads according to IPRS Version 2.1; where a break-up was not available, the salary has been considered only as 'Maximum earning potential'.
 - c. Proof of acceptance of the offers is indicated by student signing the offer letter. Such proof was not available for 39 students.
4. The number of students opting out of the placement process has been established through written communication from the students.

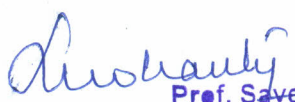

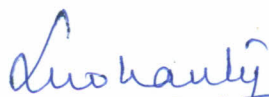

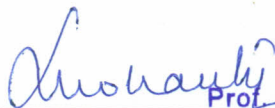
